## Wireless Network Code of Conduct Agreement

The EARC operates a wireless network for use by members under the “Exempt Network” provision of the Telecommunications Act 1997. Before being granted access to the Wireless Network, all members must agree to the following Code of Conduct, including in relation to Peered Networks.

1. Members shall abide by the relevant regulations of the Australian Communications and Media Authority (ACMA),
2. Members shall ensure that content not appropriate for “all-ages” or not intended for free public distribution is not publicly accessible,
3. Members shall not offer carriage services for a fee,
4. Members shall be courteous and polite when accessing services available on any network,
5. Members shall treat assets of any peered network with respect and not attempt to engage in malicious activity including, but not limited to, hacking, spamming, denial of service, DNS poisoning, route poisoning, RF attacks,
6. Although peered as networks, members must go through appropriate channels for accessing any host site operated by the respective organisations or individual members,
7. Any member that does not abide by this Code of Conduct will have their network access blocked and will be referred to the Committee for further action.

**I hereby acknowledge I have read, understood and agree to abide by the terms of the EARC Wireless Network Code of Conduct and acknowledge that failure to do so may lead to the blocking of my wireless connection and possible further action by the EARC Committee.**
